Activity:

Can you design a vehicle fit for a superhero, what special powers will it have? What type of vehicle will it be – car/bike/plane/train



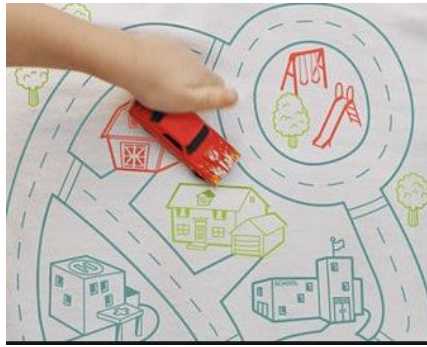
Extend further: What other types of vehicles can you think of, can you make a list or draw a picture of all the vehicles you have used?

## Making a Map

Area of Learning: Expressive Art & Design/ Physical Development/ Literacy

Activity:

Think about a journey you make often, to the shops, school, a family member. Sing some paper and colouring pencils can you draw a map of your journey. How do you get there? Walking, car, bike? What do you pass on your journey? Draw those important land marks.



Extend further: Use your map and make the journey, how accurate was your map? Did you miss anything out that you need to add?

Go for a walk and take some paper and a pencil with you, go on a number hunt and see what numbers you can find on the different car number plates. Have a go at writing them on your piece of paper.




Extend further: Look at the numbers you have collected on your paper, did you see all the numbers from 0-9?

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### The Transport Song


(Sing to the tune of 'Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star'.)
