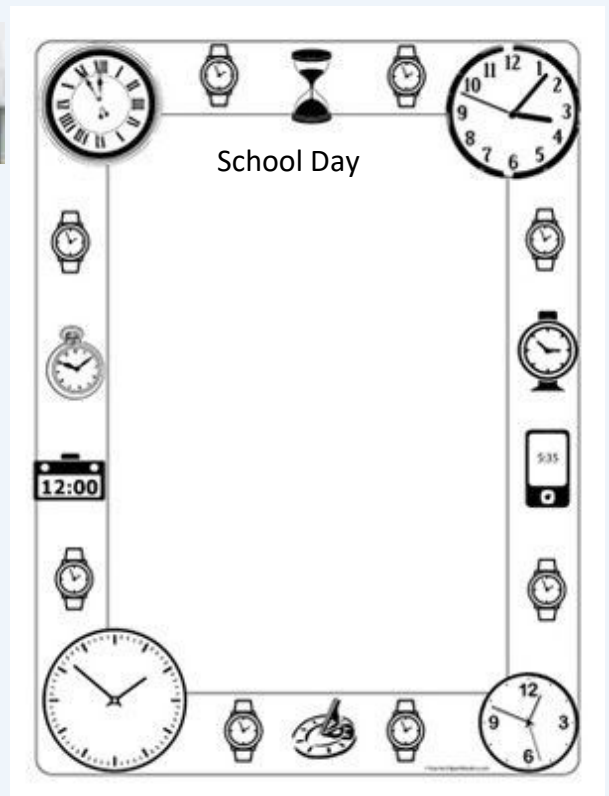

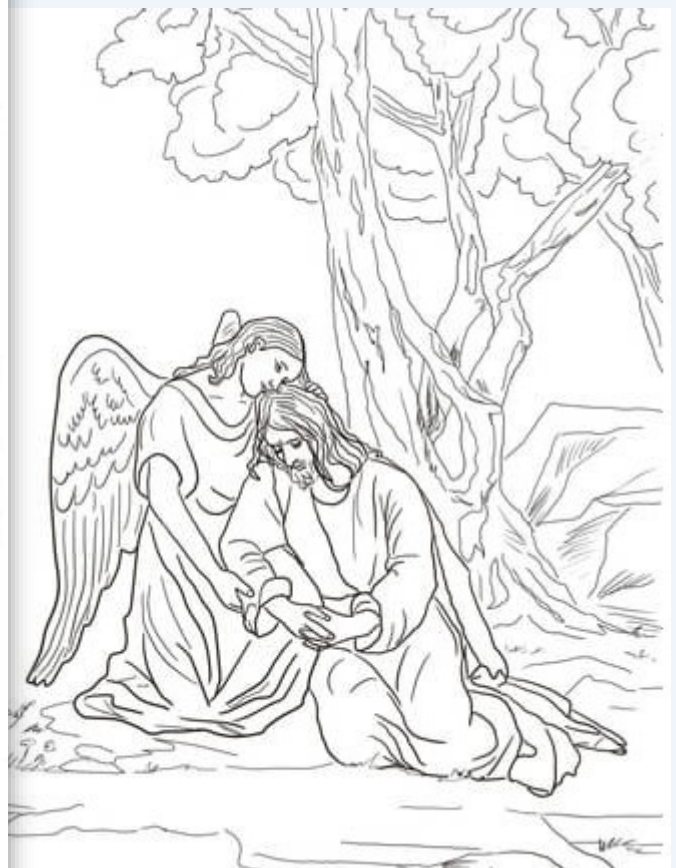


Holy Week
