## St Teresa's Catholic Primary School School Uniform Policy

## Aims and objectives

Our policy on school uniform is based on the belief that school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in our school;
- Helps to create a sense of community and belonging towards the school;
- Identifies the children with the school;
- Supports our commitment to inclusion;
- Prevents children from wearing fashion items that could be distracting in class;
- Is practical, smart and designed with health and safety in mind;
- Is good value for money.


## Jewellery, Hair Ornaments, Make-up and Nail Varnish

For health and safety reasons, and to ensure full curriculum entitlement we do not allow children to wear jewellery. The only exception to this is a watch that is fitted to the wrist for children in key stage two.

Hair bands, ribbons, bows or scrunchies should be plain and either black or dark blue. Hair bands should not have ornamentation attached (e.g. flowers).

Make up and nail varnish are not permitted at school, unless for an out of school hours function such as a school disco.

All long hair must be tied back with suitable elastics, hair ties, clips or bands. Coloured hair is not acceptable in school. This includes dying, bleaching, highlights or lowlights, coloured hair extensions, plaits or braids. Beaded braids are not permitted.

Extreme hairstyles, such as a Mohican, are not appropriate for school. The use of styling products should be kept to a minimum and children should not have decorative patterns cut into their hair.

Parents of children who come to school with unacceptable hairstyles will be contacted and given until the following weekend to rectify it.

## Footwear

For health and safety reasons we do not allow children to wear shoes with platform soles or high heels. All children are required to wear plain black shoes without logos as stated in the uniform list. School shoes should not be styled to look like trainers.. If boots are worn to travel to/from school, they should change into school shoes whilst insidethe school building.

## The Role of Parents

It is the responsibility of parents to ensure that their child has the correct uniform and PE kit, that it is clean, in good repair and that the child's name is clearly marked on all item. If a parent has difficulties for any reason in fulfilling these expectations, they are asked to speak confidentially to the Headteacher. Parents are assured that we will do all we can to help.

## The Role of Governors

The Governing Board supports the Headteacher in implementing the school uniform policy. It considers all representations from parents regarding the uniform policy and liaises with the Headteacher to ensure that the policy is implemented fairly and with sensitivity. It is the governors' responsibility to ensure that the school uniform meets all regulations concerning equal opportunities. Governors ensure that the school uniform policy enables children to dress sensibly, in clothing that is hardwearing, safe and practical.

## Monitoring and Review

The governing board monitors and reviews the school uniform policy through its committee work by:

- Seeking the views of parents, to ensure that they agree with and support the policy;
- Considering, with the Headteacher, any requests from parents for individual children to have special dispensation with regard to school uniform.
