# Welcome back for Summer Term!

#### Key Stage Two Swimming Update:

Dear Parents,

As you may be aware, swimming is a legal requirement in the primary curriculum in England. It is important that our students learn how to swim for their own safety and wellbeing, as well as to ensure they meet the national curriculum standards.

Unfortunately, the local pool we use, **The Basildon Lower Academy Pool**, is currently undergoing refurbishment and modernisation. While we are eager to resume our usual swimming lessons for years 4/5 during the Summer Term, we are unable to do so due to the pool's closure.

We have explored other options, including using pools further away from our school. However, this would result in increased costs for coach travel, which we do not believe is a viable solution.

Therefore, we have made the decision to postpone the swimming lessons for years 4/5 until next year when the refurbishment is completed. This means that next year, those students who will be in years 5/6 will attend their swimming lessons.

We understand that swimming is an important part of our curriculum, and we apologise for any inconvenience this may cause. We will continue to update you on the situation.


