Key Vocabulary

Physical changes	Natural changes that are not caused by humans.
Human changes	Things that have been built or changed by people.
Village	A group of houses and associated buildings.
Valley	A low area of land between hills or mountains.
NESW	North, east, south, west on a compass.
Saturated	Holding as much water or moisture as can be absorbed.
Natural event	Events not caused by humans such as a fire, earthquake, flood, volcano, storm, hurricane, tsunamis.
Regeneration	Upgrading of existing urban, rural, industrial and commercial areas .
Plot lands	A small piece of land that has been marked or measured for a particular purpose.
