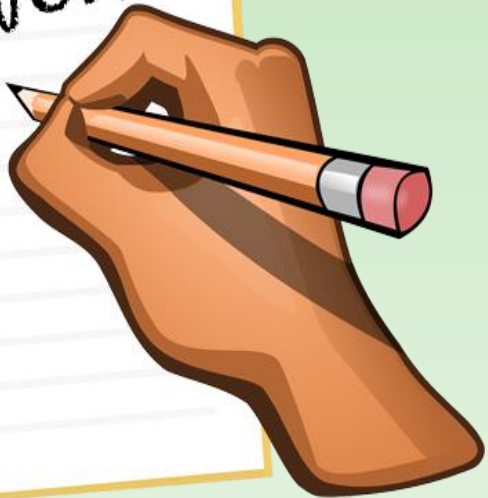

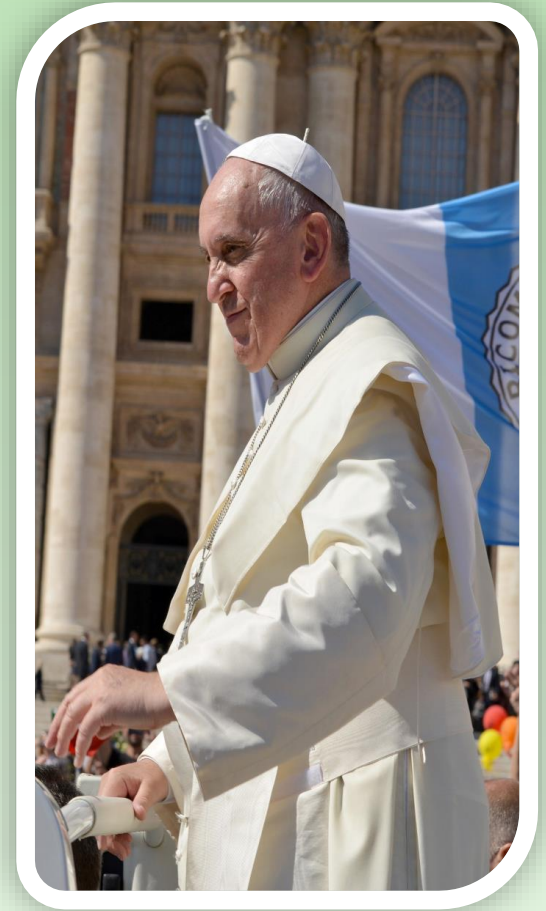

Questions


- How does the gift of the Sacrament of Reconciliation help restore friendship with God and others?

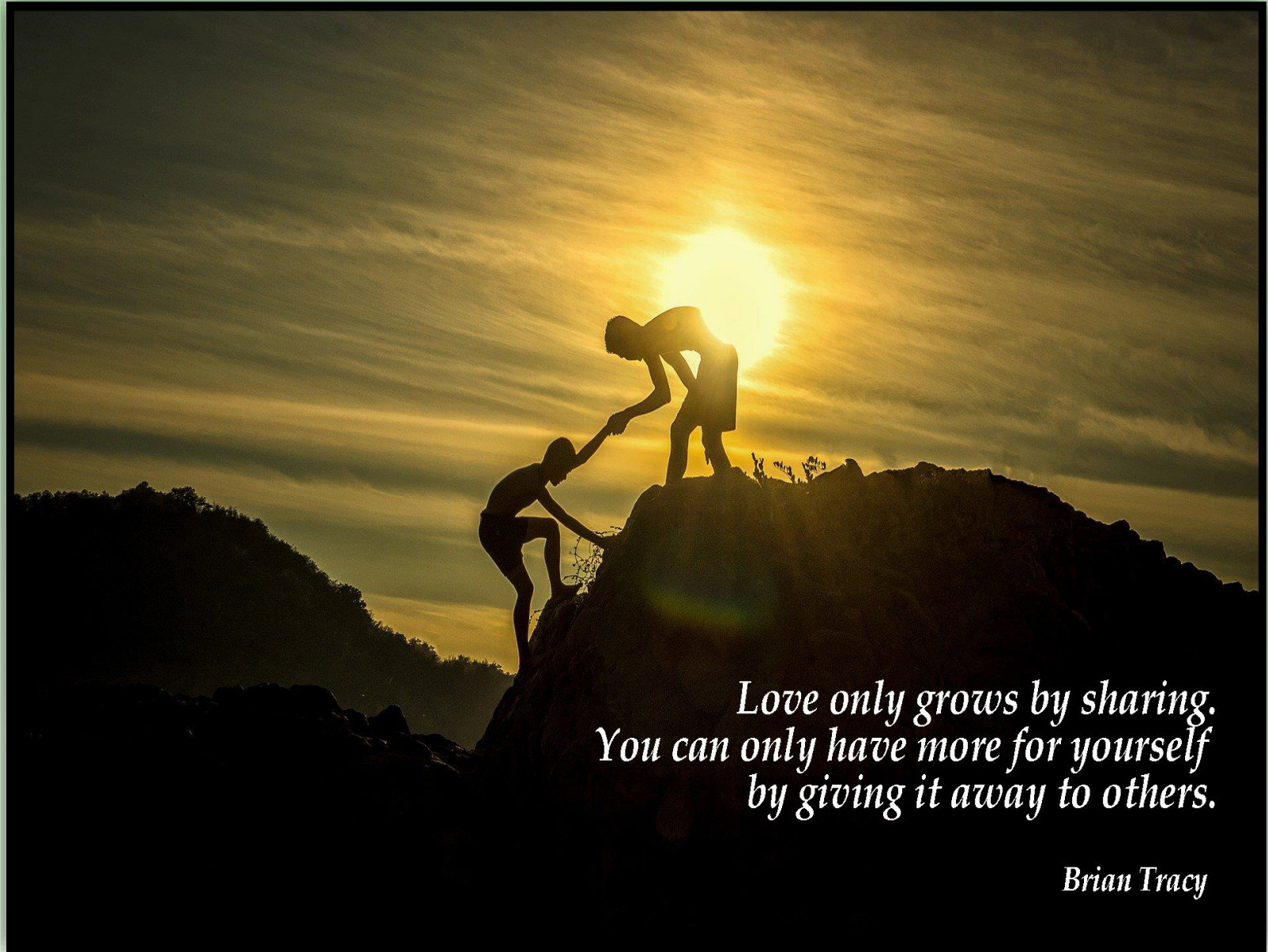
