### **Implementation:**

**Training and Development:** Provide ongoing training and development opportunities for the specially trained pastoral staff to enhance their skills in mentoring, interventions, and providing emotional and social support. New pastoral staff being employed and trained.

**Collaboration:** Foster strong partnerships with external agencies and services to ensure families in need have access to a wide range of support services.

**Regular Monitoring:** Implement a system for regular monitoring and evaluation of the support provided to children with pupil premium and their families.

### **Impact:**

**Improved Wellbeing:** Expect to see an improvement in the emotional and social wellbeing of children with pupil premium through the support provided by the specially trained pastoral staff.

**Increased Engagement:** Anticipate an increase in engagement and participation of children with pupil premium in school activities and interventions.

**Enhanced Family Support:** Aim for a higher level of support and engagement from families in need, leading to improved outcomes for both children and their families.

### **Sustainability and Next Steps:**

**Review and Reflect:** Regularly review the impact of the support provided by the pastoral staff to identify areas of success and areas for improvement.

**Resource Allocation:** Ensure continued funding and resources are allocated to sustain the employment of the specially trained pastoral staff. (This is especially important with the falling number of PPG students at St Teresa's at this time)

**Expansion:** Consider expanding the reach of the support services to reach more children with pupil premium and families in need within the school community including the organisation of TAF meetings when the need arises.
