Full PE kit in school with all items labelled?

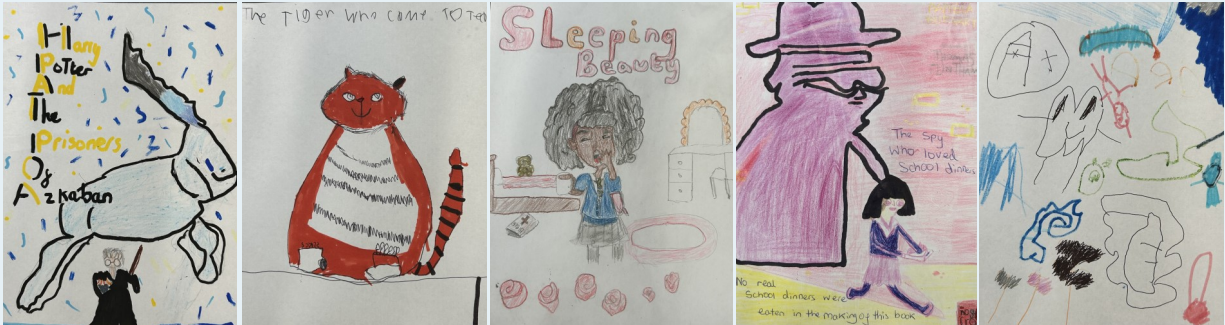
Had an early night, a break from screens and a decent amount of sleep?
