Year 4 Multiplication Screening: But that's not all – our Year 4 students have also given us reason to celebrate. This year's multiplication check results were nothing short of outstanding. An impressive 67% of students achieved full marks, with 90% scoring well above average marks on this test. These are the highest results we've ever seen, and they reflect the incredible effort put in by both students, their families and the brilliant Mrs Joyce.
