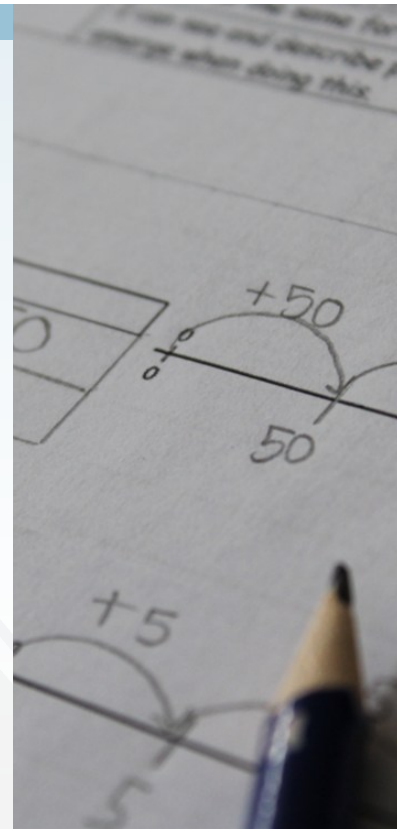


Space: The Final Frontier!
