

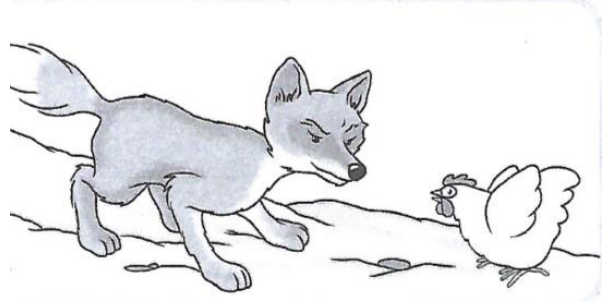
Thursday 7th May - literacy
